Sports Coaching - £4,920

We have used funding to employ a specialist qualified Sports Coach who delivers ½ day of curriculum PE and an after school club. The coach works alongside teachers in lessons to increase their subject knowledge and confidence in PE, she also works alongside after school staff to develop their skills and knowledge.

The coach is employed from the All Active Kids coaching agency – a commercial provider. We rate the quality of the coaching sessions delivered as good with outstanding features. The coaches are quality assured and a written report of the observation was shared with the school.

IMPACT:

All teachers reported increased confidence in teaching PE, for example:

- * New teaching ideas for multi-skills
- * Demonstrations of new games/athletics
- * Warm and cool down games developed
- * Confidence developed through team teaching alongside the coach

Quality of Physical Education curriculum time lessons has improved as teachers are demonstrating new teaching skills and techniques acquired from the Sports Coach.

Participation in a multi-skills afterschool club has enabled twelve children to access specialist training and therefore develop excellent gymnastic skills and techniques.

Professional Learning – £ 652

Teachers have received additional training in Gymnastics through observing and having opportunity to team teach with a Qualified Gymnastics teacher.

Funds were used to provide cover staff to release the teacher and professional development opportunities.

IMPACT:

Teacher's knowledge of teaching sports, delivery of PE through theory and practical workshops was significantly increased. Feedback to staff in purposeful staff meeting on PE shared new skills and knowledge with the whole team.

Teachers confidence when teaching gymnastics greatly increased and new teaching ideas for gymnastics, technical vocabulary for balances developed, e.g. counter/dynamic/static

Specialist Equipment and Storage - £2,000

We have bought some new equipment to enable all pupils to be active during PE lessons and also it increases the range of sports we can offer. We now have new equipment for multi skills and athletics.

We are planning to develop our provision of sports equipment outside for children to access independently. This work will be completed during August 2014.

IMPACT:

* The school is able to offer greater sporting experiences, e.g. hockey, cricket and tennis, as well as range of sports to children.

* The school has plans to develop the provision of PE equipment to ensure children are able to access equipment independently at break and lunchtimes, which means that children have greater opportunities for sports and independent learning.

Training for Midday Supervisors: £480

All Active Kids have provided weekly Positive Play sessions at lunchtimes for the children and training sessions for MDS on outdoor playground games to develop and increase sports participation at lunchtimes.

IMPACT:

Up to 50% of children are keen to take part in lunchtime games and activities and staff are more able to engage in physical activity with children.
