Weekly Round Up

Pebbles

Pebbles enjoyed singing travelling songs this week, they enjoyed working in pairs and doing lots of actions whilst singing along to: The wheels on the bus, I ride my bicycle, Row, row, row your boat and Helicopter spin.

They enjoyed listening to the story of The Very Hungry Caterpillar, they made a dance routine starting off as a caterpillar who spins into a cocoon and eventually turns into a beautiful butterfly. The children wore butterfly wings to fly around the spaces inside and out.

The Pebbles children have also enjoyed building dens on the decking! We have been very impressed with their designs!



Ladybirds

This week in Ladybirds we have been very busy learning our Supertato text map. We have looked at what kind of character Supertato is and have written a character description. We took it in turns to be in the hot seat pretending we are the Evil Pea whilst questions were asked of us. We have looked at speech bubbles and had a go at writing some to the Evil Pea pretending we were a vegetable in need of help or had been caught by the Evil Pea. We loved making jelly to trap the Evil Pea!

In mathematics we have been looking at sharing and grouping. If objects have been shared out equally or not, for example the difference of sharing 12 objects between 2, 3 or 4 people. In grouping for example we have 12 bricks but want them to be in blocks of 2, 3 or 4 and how many towers would we make. Lots of counting in ones and tens.

In phonics we have continued to recap all sounds to date with focus on reading and writing longer words.



Woodland Class

In English, Woodland Class have been busy learning their new Talk 4 Writing text 'The Red Crayon's Complaint'. This week the children have been learning how to add -er and -est suffixes to adjectives and have been using the conjunction 'if' to link clauses together.

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In mathematics, Year 1 have been learning about quarters and have been identifying quarters of a shape or quantity. Year 2 have been learning about unit and non-unit fractions. They have also been learning about the equivalence of $2/4$ and $1/2$.

In art this week, the children enjoyed making 3D sculptures using coloured paper. The children first practised making 3D shapes such as loops, zigzags and spirals before creating their own unique sculptures.

In science, the children have started their new topic on plants. This week, the children identified a variety of common plants and trees. We then discussed the importance of plants before writing instructions on how to plant a seed. We will be using our instructions in the coming weeks to plant our own beans.



Kestrel Class

In English this week, the class have been introduced to our new unit of persuasive writing. For the hook they had to work in groups to persuade Miss Barrow and Mrs Burkitt why they should be given some privileges; such as extra break time, extra golden time and a class pet. They came up with some very convincing arguments! We have also started to map and learn our new focus text; Perfect Parrot for Sale. In mathematics, Nemos finished learning about time and solved problems with units of time. They have now started learning about shape and looked at turns and angles. Frogs have continued learning about shape; this week they have identified, compared and ordered angles, and also started looking at different types of triangles.

In Art and D&T we started off with an art gallery walkaroud to admire the 3D sculptures that were created at the end of last half term. We have also been looking at bridges from around the world and learning about the different types of bridges, such as suspension, cantilever and truss bridges.

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Osprey Class

This week in English, Osprey Class have started their new discussion topic: Who is to blame for the tragedy in the Highwayman. We began by reading Highwayman by Alfred Noyes and have used drama to understand the plot and motives behind the terrible tragedy.

In mathematics, Year 5's have been completing translations and reflections of shapes using coordinates.

Year 6's have taken this one step further and have been using 4 quadrants to translate and reflect said shapes.

This week in D&T we have been planning our designs for our waistcoats. We have also looked into the history of waistcoats and how they can be used to express individual style. Thank you to everyone who has donated materials for this project - they are wonderful!

Barn Owls

In English, our new persuasive writing unit is off to a flying start, with Barn Owls working closely with Kestrel Class. We put Mrs. Burkitt and Miss. Barrow's minds to the test, presenting arguments on a variety of topics. Our **excellent persuasion skills** even earned us an extra gem in the jar and five extra minutes of playtime (though we couldn't quite convince them to scrap maths lessons!). We've also started learning our new Talk 4 Writing text, 'Perfect Parrot for Sale' by mapping the text.

In mathematics, we've been started our **shape unit**. The children have been exploring **acute, right, and obtuse angles**, and mastering the vocabulary of **horizontal, vertical, parallel, and perpendicular** lines.
