Pebbles

It has been busy in Pebbles Nursery this week but the children have had amazing fun! We are so proud of how brave and brilliant the children were in their first ever Christmas Nativity. They were really lovely little sheep and won the audience over with their cute performances.

We painted wonderful Christmas Trees, using our fingers to paint lots of colourful fairy lights. We also worked hard on an activity to make a melting snowman, with googly eyes, a carrot nose and real buttons. The children enjoyed playing with the frozen ice blocks that had penguins hidden inside. They used hammers to help crack the ice and water to thaw it to help free the penguins.

We have been reading lots of Christmas books every day, sitting quietly and listening beautifully to all the magical stories of reindeers, snow angels and jingle bells!

Ladybirds

Ladybirds were very excited to get dressed up and perform their Nativity to an audience; they were amazing and had worked so hard to learn all the songs. We have explored the Nativity story and related it to our own wonderful performance.

In maths we went on a shape hunt exploring our environment looking for squares and rectangles. We thought about if we had found more squares or rectangles. We have thought about day and night and different activities that we do at different times of the day.

Woodland Class

In English, Woodland Class have been busy writing their persuasive leaflets. The children have been focusing on using alliteration and boastful words such as 'incredible', 'amazing', 'spectacular' to persuade their readers to visit their Christmas theme parks.

In science, we learned about the weather and seasonal changes in spring. We discussed how the trees change in spring and how new animals are born including lambs, ducklings and chicks. Year 1 sorted pictures into winter and spring whilst Year 2 wrote sentences to describe the changes in spring.

On Tuesday, Woodland Class enjoyed performing their Nativity with Ladybirds and Pebbles.


Christmas Lunch
